CARRIAGEWAY RECONSTRUCTION & RESURFACING WORKS IN YORK AVENUE, EAST COWES

Dear resident

Further to last week's update, the switch over between Phase 2 and Phase 3 was successful on Friday afternoon. We are now undertaking works within Phase 3 between Adelaide Grove and a point 60 metres north-west of Connaught Road. During this phase traffic is diverted via Victoria Grove and Adelaide Grove as indicated in the following link:

To enable the safe passing of traffic along this diversion route we have placed parking restrictions in various sections along both Victoria Grove and Adelaide Grove. These parking restrictions are indicated by orange no waiting cones and highlighted on the maps in our wooden display boards with purple lines.

We would like to take this opportunity to stress the importance of these cones for safety and we would remind you to kindly find alternative parking whilst these restrictions are in place.

Should any vehicles parked within these coned areas be causing an obstruction to the flow of traffic, Island Roads would need to take measures to relocate these vehicles. In addition, parking services are permitted to issue parking tickets to those who do not follow the temporary legal order in place.

Of course, whilst we must ensure the diversion route is flowing freely, we would like to avoid these instances and therefore hope this serves as a gentle reminder to those in the local area.

We know these temporary restrictions do cause some inconvenience to residents and we really are grateful for your ongoing co-operation.

We will continue to keep you updated as we progress the scheme.
