

Dear residents and stakeholders,

Please see below an update prior to recommencement of the carriageway reconstruction and resurfacing work in Wroxall.

General Information for Residents Directly Affected in Phase 4 (Station Road to Coombe Park)

- Work will recommence on Monday 5th January 2026, covering the section between Station Road and Coombe Park, with the road closure coming into force from approximately 08:30.
- During Phase 4, if you have an off-street parking area, there may be a period when access will be temporarily unavailable depending on the location of excavations. Unfortunately, we are unable to confirm the exact duration at this stage, as the depth and extent of excavation will depend on ground conditions, which can only be assessed once work begins.
- If you require use of your vehicle during this time, then please make arrangements to park in an alternative location. The Isle of Wight Council Parking Services team has agreed to relax parking restrictions in Wroxall during the works, however you must ensure that you park your vehicle in a safe location, ie away from bends, junctions and narrow sections of carriageways. Any vehicle deemed to be causing an obstruction to scheme progress, site traffic, bus services, emergency services or waste collection vehicles will be removed.
- There are a number of premises where there is no pavement between the pedestrian access and the carriageway. We will be reviewing this and be in contact with these residents directly.
- Thalia Waste Management requests that your waste is on the kerbside before 7 am on your usual collection day to enable them to be collected.
- Coombe Park – vehicular access will be via the north (Whiteley Bank)
- Grove Road – although the road closure will be between Station Road and Coombe Park, smaller sub-phases of work within this closure will aim to maintain access to Grove Road as far as reasonably practicable, without compromising the safety of the public or site operatives. However, as the excavation will cross the length of the Grove Road junction, there may be short periods when access is not possible and we recommend liaising directly with the operatives on site during this phase, as they will be able to advise when access is likely to be affected.
- Station Road – vehicular access will be via the south (Upper Ventnor), and a set of temporary traffic signals will be placed at the junction to maintain safe vehicular access.

Monday 5th January 2026 – Important Information

Please be advised that a funeral will take place at St Johns Church, Wroxall on this day. Access between Whitely Bank and the church will be available for the funeral cortège and attendees between 12:30 and 13:00.

On this day, we will primarily be focusing on mobilising the site in preparation for excavation works. Activities scheduled include:

- Installation of road closure signage, diversion routes, and site security measures
- Delivery of construction plant and machinery
- Site induction update for workers, covering health and safety procedures and outlining how the work will be carried out

Shuttle Bus & School Buses
