



Dear residents and stakeholders,

We are writing to provide you with an update on the ongoing carriageway reconstruction and resurfacing work in Wroxall.

#### **Phase 4 (Station Road to Coombe Park)**

- We are pleased to inform you that we were able to complete the surfacing works today as planned. Please note that due to the operatives' annual leave, the lining works will be completed next week.

#### **General Information for Residents Directly Affected in Phase 5 (Coombe Park to Appuldurcombe Road)**

- Due to the weather warning in place for tomorrow (Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> January 2026), phase 5 will commence on Friday 16th January 2026. The current traffic arrangements will stay in place until Friday morning, when we will adjust the traffic management and site security ahead of commencing the excavation works.
- Although the road closure will be between Coombe Park and Appuldurcombe Road, smaller sub-phases of work within this closure will aim to maintain access to off-street parking areas as far as reasonably practicable, without compromising the safety of the public or site operatives. The two sub-phases will be a) Coombe Park to Avenue Road and b) Avenue Road to Appuldurcombe Road.
- During Phase 5, if you have an off-street parking area, there may be a period when access will be temporarily unavailable depending on the location of excavations. Unfortunately, we are unable to confirm the exact duration at this stage, as the depth and extent of excavation will depend on ground conditions, which can only be assessed once work begins.
- If you require use of your vehicle during this time, then please make arrangements to park in an alternative location. The Isle of Wight Council Parking Services team has agreed to relax parking restrictions in Wroxall during the works, however you must ensure that you park your vehicle in a safe location, ie away from bends, junctions and narrow sections of carriageways. Any vehicle deemed to be causing an obstruction to scheme progress, site traffic, bus services, emergency services or waste collection vehicles will be removed.
- There are a number of premises where there is no pavement between the pedestrian access and the carriageway. We will be reviewing this and be in contact with these residents directly.
- Thalia Waste Management requests that your waste is on the kerbside before 7 am on your usual collection day to enable them to be collected.
- Coombe Park – vehicular access will be via the south (Upper Ventnor)
- Avenue Road – vehicular access will be via the north (Appuldurcombe Road and Whiteley Bank)
- Appuldurcombe Road - vehicular access will be via the north (Whiteley Bank)



### **Shuttle Bus & School Buses**
